AFFIRMATION OF FAITH - APOSTLES' CREED

Prayer & Blessing Congregational Welcome We invite children to come to the front at this time for their own special message. At the conclusion of children's time, kids 5th grade and under are invited to join us upstairs for Sunday School. An adult will be at the back of the sanctuary to escort kids to their room.

In Presbyterian tradition, we often baptize infants as an acknowledgment that they are part of the covenant of faith. The parents profess faith on behalf of the child, and they promise to raise the child in the faith until the child can make his or her own profession of faith. The church also makes promises to help instruct the child in the faith.

By choosing to participate in confirmation, a young person receives specific instruction in the faith with the goal of helping them make their own decision to accept the faith in which they were raised as their own.

Confirmation then is a continuation of the faith journey that began at baptism and continues throughout their whole lives. It is an opportunity to celebrate the youth of our church, their decision to make a public profession of faith, and to recognize the gifts they bring to our community. It is also a time to remember our own baptismal covenant and the faith we profess in Jesus Christ, recommitting ourselves to greater spiritual growth and discipleship.
